Correct Answer + 2 point shot = x x x x

Correct Answer + 3 point shot = x x x x x

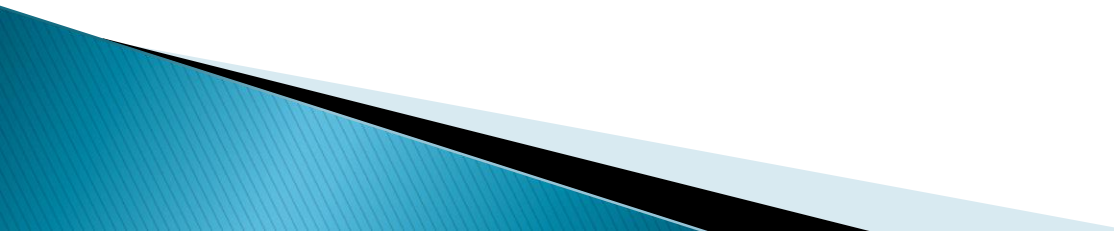
